Old Business: Trash Pick UP: Supervisor Stone indicated he has been working with the township attorney and will figure out how to get this trash pick up off the ground and started.

New Business: The E Poll Book laptop for elections needs to be replaced with one with Windows 10, motion to authorize cost of \$243 plus tax for purchase of new EPB for the township, made by Engle, supported by Daniels, motion carried.

Tim Krumm, Assessor needs mandatory ECF AMAR training for Grant and Burleigh Townships to take place in Lincoln Park, costs of training to be split by the townships, motion to authorize training fee up to \$2,000 for ECF training made by McClure, support by Jordan, motion carried.
