

# BURLEIGH TOWNSHIP MINUTES

OCTOBER 5, 2022

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited at 7:00 p.m.

Board Members present: Supervisor Chris Stone, Treasurer Sharren Engle, Clerk Stacy McClure, Trustee Paul Birkenbach, Trustee Matt Jordan

Clerk read Minutes from September meeting, Motion to Accept Minutes made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Financial report was submitted by Engle, GF \$307,396.23, R & B \$29,734.54, motion to approve made by Birkenbach, supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Bills were read by Clerk, motion to pay bills made by Birkenbach, supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Committee Report: None

Old Business: Cemetery was surveyed and it was determined that the NE corner is Colvin property and not on the plat. Graves should be measured 4 x 8 with a 3 foot walkway and residents may obtain up to 4 free with the option to purchase 4 more maximum. Clerk is still working on obtaining information on how to go about mapping and marking the current sites, including a system in place for better recordkeeping.

Hall improvements were again discussed, including an estimate on fixing and/or update the plumbing in the amount of \$2,500 from Colvins. Graves well drilling gave an estimate of \$7,390.00 for a new well system and it was agreed that we need to look into new LED lighting for the hall, among other improvements.

There is approximately \$40,000 left from the ARPA funds received.

Clark Bailo submitted a property split to the Assessor which he approved, it was then presented to the Board, motion to approve made by Birkenbach supported by Jordan.

Public comment(s): Residents living on Turtle Road near 65 made complaints about engine brake noise from the truck traffic.
